In order to keep families well informed of the evolution of the situation in our establishment, here is the situation today:

1 positive case stable1 death stable3 recovered residents stable

0 positive employee

4 recovered employees stable

The situation is still stable at CHSLD Heather, but we remain very vigilant and continue to carry out daily surveillance of residents and rigorously maintain and adjust the measures in place to ensure everyone's safety and avoid possible transmission between infected residents and others.

The CHSLD deconfinement plan has been initiated. However, both inside and outside establishments, infection prevention and control measures must be followed to avoid the resumption of transmission.

Visits are authorized and open to families, but to prepare for your visit, a meeting must be agreed between you and the site coordinator of your CHSLD. No one will be able to access an establishment without going through this process. The procedure will be the same as that we had done for family caregivers.
